

COVID 19 SAFTEY PRECAUTIONS

COVID-19 still remains at the top of people's concerns, and in the world of Beauty it has affected the way we experience certain luxury services, Makeup & Hair being one of them. I personally want to assure you that I've always taken the health & safety of my clients very seriously by practicing the highest standards of sanitation procedures. But now it's more important than ever to let you know exactly what precautions I take to keep my clients Safe & *My Kit* Clean & Sanitized.

- Since makeup artistry is a very intimate service, being face to face with my clients I respect your personal space & I always wear my hair pulled back, a face mask & a face shield or protective eye wear for every application.
- I ask my clients to reschedule if they are feeling unwell, in anyway, as well as take temperatures before any services are performed. No fees will be charged for rescheduling due to illness.
- All Brushes & Tools go through a Deep Clean Wash with Soap & *HiBiCLENSE*, U/V Light & 70% alcohol to disinfect, before every service.
- All Brushes & Tools are divided into separate "*Personal Kits*" for all clients, to assure no cross contamination.
- Always washing hands and using hand sanitizer in front of each client prior to starting application. Gloves also may be worn.
- Disposable applicators or tools are used when possible.
- Palettes and ALL Cosmetics will be disinfected between clients with 70% alcohol. A 15 min "Sanitation" time is scheduled between services for Bridal Parties to assure proper amount of Dry Time.
- For in Studio Services, I ask you to come alone; only 1 Client is allowed in studio at a time.
- On the day of the wedding or event, I ask that only the person receiving an application be within 10 feet of my *Makeup Station*.
- If a client feels more comfortable wearing a mask during application process, I ask that you just remove it for base and lip application.

All Clients are required to sign a Covid19 Waiver before services. Please feel free to voice your questions or concerns through email.
